In accordance with Chapter 22 of the Acts of 2022, relating to the 2020 novel Coronavirus outbreak, **the June 15, 2022 public meeting of the Falmouth Historical Commission shall be physically closed to the public to avoid group congregation.**

Alternative public access to this meeting shall be provided in the following manner:

1. Real-time public comment can be addressed to the Historical Commission utilizing the Zoom virtual meeting software for remote access. This application will allow users to view the meeting and send a comment or question to the Chair via the Chat function. Submitted text comments will be read into the record at the appropriate points in the meeting.

2. Additionally public comments may be sent in advance of the meeting to fhc@falmouthma.gov at least 5 hours prior to the beginning of the meeting. Documents and audio or video files may also be submitted via email. Submitted email comments and documents will be made a part of the meeting record and may be read into the record, summarized, or displayed during the meeting at the discretion of the chair.
3. Applicants, their representatives, and individuals with enforcement matters before the Historic Commission may appear remotely and are not required to be physically present. Applicants, their representatives, and individuals with enforcement matters before the Historic Commission may contact the Planning Department to arrange an alternative means of real time participation if unable to use the Zoom virtual meeting software. Documentary exhibits and/or visual presentations should be submitted in advance of the meeting to the fhc@falmouthma.gov so that they may be displayed for remote public access viewing.
