 - Nobska Bridge repair is on the November Town Meeting warrant, if passed, will go out to bid in December with work beginning in Spring
 - Fay Road detour
 - We discussed requesting riders to walk bikes up and down the connection to the SSBW
 - Root lift issues in WH, reprioritize or seek alternative solutions
 - Potential for increased budget via Town Hall meeting in Spring
 - Potential for summer staff person in operating budget
 - Planned work

 - There are concept drawings that are about 5 years old for the section between Sandwich and Gifford
 - Preference would be for a grassy strip as a traffic barrier + a 12 foot wide multi-use path
 - Jim McGloughlin to work with BPC on evaluating where/how to begin
