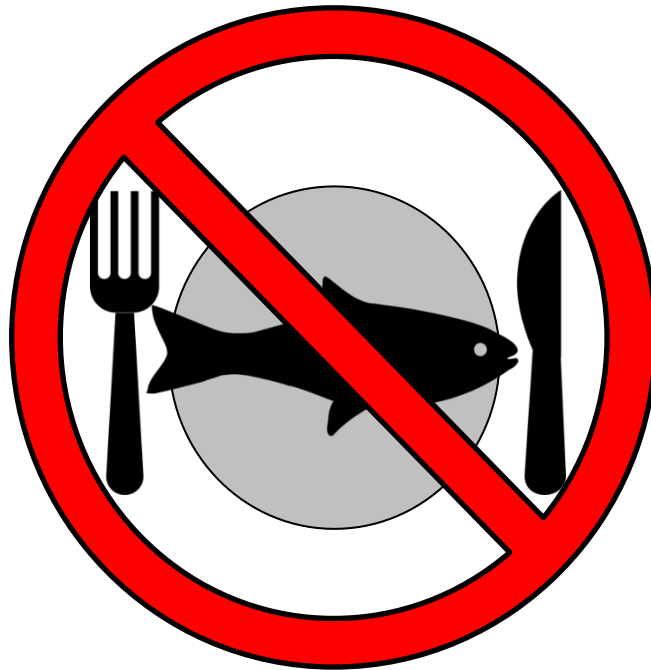

**CHILDREN UNDER 12, PREGNANT
WOMEN, NURSING MOTHERS, AND
WOMEN OF CHILDBEARING AGE WHO
MAY BECOME PREGNANT:**

- ◆ Do not eat any fish: catch & release

ALL OTHER PEOPLE:

- ◆ Limit consumption of all fish to two meals per week
