



Mandatory Recycling Regulations



Mandatory...



In order to protect the environment, promote recycling and comply with the MassDEP Waste Bans (310 CMR 19.017), the Town of Falmouth hereby establishes a requirement for mandatory separation of recyclable materials from the solid waste stream.

This requirement applies to all residential and commercial generators in the Town of Falmouth. This requirement does not extend to separation of recyclable materials from solid waste generated by the public and disposed in public receptacles.


Mass DEP's list of items and materials banned from Disposal or Incineration.

Drop-Off




**Waste Management Facility will accept
Single Stream Recyclables**

- **Sticker or Daily Fee Required**
- **Fee of \$2.50 per each 32 Gallon Qty.**
- **Begins April 10, 2023**

Mandatory Recycling Regulations

Haulers

- **Permitted Trash Haulers must also offer collection of Recyclables.**
- **Haulers must guarantee that the final destination of recyclable materials is a licensed Materials Recovery Facility.**




