
Project Goals

ADD YOUR OWN GOALS

- Extend scope to Staples - 100's of new residents and much commercial development exists
- Install parking meters at certain locations. Changing parking during certain time ~~times~~ e.g. summer (with more demand). But eliminate charging (i.e. provide free parking during off season. e.g. as Plymouth)
- Important to assess whether there is a problem - or not. Strongly opposed to any one-way solutions.
- Data should not just reflect summer parking levels. Address how public transit affects parking demand.
- Reduce parking requirements.
- Eliminate parking on one side of Main Street to enlarge travel lanes.
- Open school parking during summer & indicate with signage.
- Have a handout of all public parking spaces that can be given out and are available in Town building for people to take.
- NEED SUMMER FOR MAX USAGE
- EXTEND SCOPE EAST TO ENCOMPASS KNOWN HIGH DENSITY DEVELOPMENTS
- USE OFF SITE PARKING WITH SHUTTLE TO DOWNTOWN
