

**PUBLIC NOTICE
TOWN OF FALMOUTH, MA – AQUACULTURE SERVICES
REQUEST FOR INTEREST**

The Town of Falmouth seeks Statements of Qualifications (SOQ) from individuals or entities interested in growing oysters at one of three sites selected by the Town in Eel River. The intent of this public-private partnership is to removing nitrogen in order to restore impaired estuaries. The Town will select one grower for each site. The grower (Aquaculture Contractor) will grow oysters and remove them on an annual basis in order to remove nitrogen from the estuary. The individuals selected will be eligible to obtain an aquaculture license for one selected site from the Board of Selectmen.

License terms will be negotiated subsequent to selection. The Town Manager reserves the right to accept and/or reject any and all proposals and waive any informality in license procedures to the extent allowed by law and make the award deemed to be in the best interest of the Town.

Copies of the Statement of Qualifications application may be obtained by sending an email with the subject “Aquaculture SOQ” to townmanager@falmouthma.gov or at the Town of Falmouth, Town Manager’s Office, 59 Town Hall Square, Falmouth, MA 02540 beginning at 9:00 A.M. on July 5, 2019.

The completed SOQ must be received by the Town Manager’s Office, 59 Town Hall Square, Falmouth, MA 02540 by 3:00 pm on Friday, July 26, 2019. Any SOQ’s received after this time and date will be returned to the applicant unopened. No exceptions will be allowed. Facsimile or electronic SOQ’s will not be accepted and postmarks will not be considered. One (1) original copy, three (3) photocopies and one (1) copy in electronic format of the SOQ must be submitted in a sealed envelope indicating the applicant’s name and address and clearly marked in the lower left hand corner, “**FALMOUTH AQUACULTURE SERVICES**”.
