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As of 9:30 a.m. today, the Town currently has 24 test positive cases of COVID-19 in our community. Proper isolation and quarantine protocols, including contact notifications, are being followed by the Massachusetts Department of Public Health, Falmouth Health Department and the Visiting Nurses Association. As COVID-19 testing rates increase, the number of positives will continue to increase. There is community spread occurring and will continue to occur as the test positive cases do not include the asymptomatic or mildly ill individuals. You can help slow the spread of this virus by committing to social distancing and practice good personal hygiene, like handwashing. Our COVID-19 team comprised of the Town Manager, Police, Fire, School Dept, Board of Health will continue to meet and take action as necessary. We will continue to update the community as this situation continues to evolve.
